Developing Independence

- "I Can" posters encourage children to learn responsibilities.
- Other signs and posters explore conflict resolution and behavior expectations.

Learning Through Experiences

- Large- and small-group learning experiences are intentionally planned by teachers, based on observation and assessment of each child's needs.
- Storytime cards focus on strong oral language and early literacy exposure, with literacy tips on Oral Language, Concepts of Print, and Understanding Stories.
